Classic aging in French oak barrels of 1 to 5 wines for 12 months

VARIFTALS

Merlot 95%, Cabernets 5%

Vegan and biodynamic, that is to say that this Merlot (85%), endowed with aromas of red fruits and cocoa, deserves a beautiful table to flourish
